Chronic Condition Management Mini Data Audit

What's involved

In February 2023, the Strengthening Medicare Taskforce released a report advocating for the implementation of Voluntary Patient Registration (VPR). Currently, patients in Australia can visit multiple GPs or clinics without formally registering with a specific practice.

While this flexibility offers choices, it can also result in fragmented care and inefficient resource allocation. Patients with chronic diseases and complex care needs are one identified group that may benefit from improved continuity of care that comes with VPR. This mini data audit, using PenCS CAT4, will help you identify patients with complex care needs for potential MyMedicare enrolment and develop a practice improvement plan.

Step 1
