Strengthening Medicare – General Practice Grant Program

The Australian Government's Strengthening Medicare – GP Grants Program is now open. The purpose of the program is to support practices to provide improved, safe, and accessible quality healthcare.

One-off grants of \$25k, \$35k and \$50k are available to eligible practices. The value of each grant has been determined by the Government based on practice size. The grants can be used in line with three streams: enhance digital health capability, upgrade infection prevention and control arrangements, and maintain and/or achieve accreditation. Practices can use their grant on one or multiple streams.

This resource has been designed to highlight models of care and resources that you may wish to consider. They are not mandatory but can be used to assist you to plan how you will use your grant in conjunction with the guidelines and implement changes within your practice.
